Dear Parents and Carers,

Did you know that you may be able to get Free School Meals? Very important-Please Read

Depending on your circumstances, your child may be able to get means tested free school meals. All children in Reception class and Years 1 and 2 are eligible for a free school meal. However, your child may also be eligible for the Pupil Premium entitlement. This not only provides your child with a free school meal, but also helps the school gain extra income and provide additional support as outlined in our Pupil Premium strategy statement that is available on our website.
