Our current value is Patience.

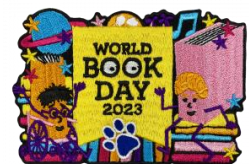
We have introduced our new value to children during assembly this week and have discussed the importance of patience and how we can show it.
