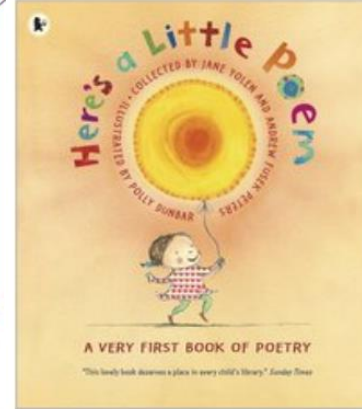
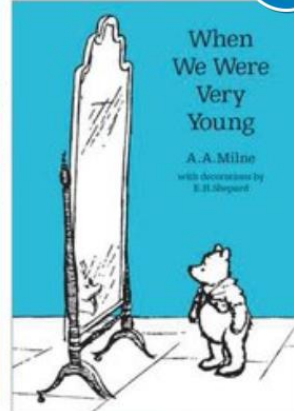
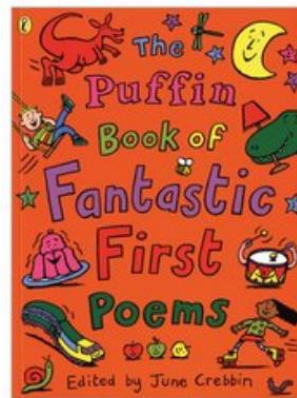
Sharing a shell

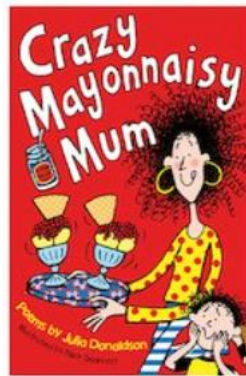
When We Were Very Young.

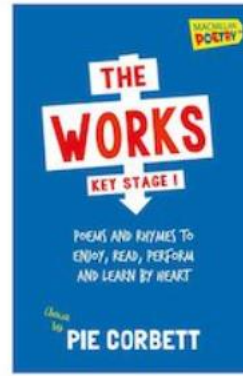

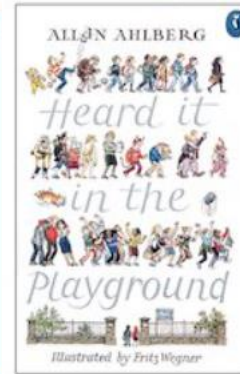
Crazy Mayonnaise Mum

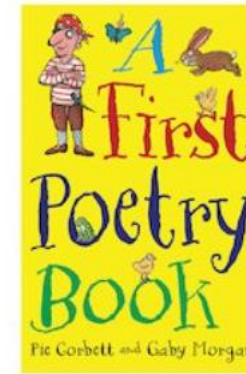

Jump into Allan Ahlberg's playful world of poetry, perfect for primary school children.

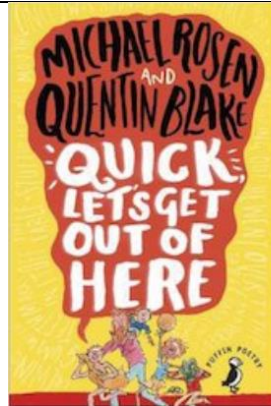
